Sundrops


Discover the beauty and benefits of gardening with desertsmart drought-tolerant plants! Long-time desert dwellers and new residents alike are becoming aware of how precious our water supply is, and both want to do their part in helping to keep our desert beautiful and sustainable. The SummerTree Institute is dedicated to providing you with tools to accomplish these goals while helping you tackle your own landscaping using an earth-friendly, low-maintenance approach, and still keep your birds singing! You'll find the journey to a water-wise landscape can happen at no cost to your lifestyle; in fact, it will enhance your lifestyle.

To help you beautify your new or existing home, we would like to introduce you to plants that thrive in our desert environment with minimal care and water. Some are our own desert native plants that are well-adapted to our unique climate, while others hail from regions across our continent and other continents with similar weather conditions.

This month's star-performing native plant is **Sundrops**, **or Fendler's Sundrops**, known botanically as *Calylophus hartwegii fendleri*.

Sundrops cheer up drab spots in your garden, and quickly spread by underground rhizomes into rounded, flower-filled mounds. Masses of yellow flowers 1-2 inches wide appear above narrow, bright green leaves over a long bloom season from March to October. Flowers open in the afternoon and remain open until the next morning, providing nectar to night-flying moths. Each flower lasts 24 hours, and then fades to orange-pink, creating a nice sunset color palette. This perennial groundcover is native to Arizona, Colorado, Kansas, New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas. It is fast growing and easy to grow, forming a mound 1 foot tall and 2 feet wide. This drought tolerant, low wateruse plant is cold hardy to 5°F. Cut back the stems of this evening primrose look-alike when it goes dormant in winter to reshape and prepare for new spring growth. Plant in well-drained soil in full sun or part shade, and even though they don't like to be overwatered, they appreciate a little extra water in summer. This tough plant takes heat and drought in stride, and is attractive between boulders, massed in clusters, or in containers.
