

Century Plant

Discover the beauty and benefits of gardening with desertsmart drought-tolerant plants! Long-time desert dwellers and new residents alike are becoming aware of how precious our water supply is, and both want to do their part in helping to keep our desert beautiful and sustainable. The SummerTree Institute is dedicated to providing you with tools to accomplish these goals while helping you tackle your own landscaping using an earth-friendly, low-maintenance approach, and still keep your birds singing! You'll find the journey to a water-wise landscape can happen at no cost to your lifestyle; in fact, it will enhance your lifestyle.

To help you beautify your new or existing home, we would like to introduce you to plants that thrive in our desert environment with minimal care and water. Some are our own desert native plants that are well-adapted to our unique climate, while others hail from regions across our continent and other continents with similar weather conditions.

This month's star-performing native plant is **Century Plant**, known botanically as *Agave americana*.

Century Plant is a large and impressive succulent that forms symmetrical rosettes of fleshy, gray-green, spiky leaves that can grow up to 6 feet long. Named from a belief that it blooms only after 100 years, it actually blooms when plants reach about 15 - 30 years old. This succulent is native to Mexico and the southwest U.S., and grows 6-10 feet tall and 10-15 feet wide. It blooms in summer, preferring full sun, and accepts reflected sun. Century Plants take very little water, and are cold hardy to 15°F. The giant flowering stalk with clusters of yellow flowers seems to grow overnight, reaching 20 to 40 feet into the sky. After flowering, the agave dies, but not before producing offsets or "pups" around the base, which continue the cycle: grow, bloom, die, create more pups and grand-pups (which can be transplanted). Century Plants can reach giant proportions, so make sure you take its full size into account before choosing where to plant one. Don't plant near curbs, walkways, driveways, or patios. You'll regret planting it anywhere you have to cut its leaves back to safely pass by it. In the right place, Century Plant is carefree, being tolerant of drought, scorching heat, poor soil, and strong winds. It makes quite a statement in southwest and Mediterranean gardens, borders, containers, in mass, or as a focal point.


